## AFIRE TIP #9 SUPPORT & PRAYER BOX



Because of the stigma surrounding addiction, many people in your parish/congregation may be afraid to reach out to your group for advice, support, prayers, or other assistance.

Consider placing a "SUPPORT & PRAYER" box in the vestibule where it is clearly visible for all to see.

Here are some useful ideas:

1.Mark the box as an AFIRE project/box.

2.Place a short description near the box that explains your AFIRE ministry.

3. Provide copies of the attached cards, or create another form.

4. Check the box frequently and respond accordingly.
